We would also be grateful to receive treats for our visitors. Recently we have provided a large container of water for a couple who are sleeping rough — they were so grateful! We also gave them a box of Maltesers for which they were absolutely delighted! They had been at rock bottom, sleeping rough,

and bereaved of a close loved one. If you could see for yourself the difference a treat or a bit of essential kit can make to someone who has lost everything your heart would sing! Last week we were able to provide socks for a client whose feet were swollen and sore and wrapped in paper towels – he was hobbling around in crocs.
