Sunday Breakfast: Last weekend we had a good number of hungry attendees at breakfast. They kept us busy, which was probably as well, for we had just been given some sad news – one of our regular attendees (who could be challenging) had undergone surgery during the week. The operation would have enabled him to discard his crutches and walk unaided. The surgery was successful but two days later, Saturday night, he died. On returning home a little later we heard that another of our regulars during the last 13 years had died of a heart attack just a couple of hours earlier. Seven of our regulars have died in the last 3 months. We miss them all – they were our friends. In a recent report we learned that 1600 homeless people died last year – most of whom had died ‘young’. What a waste of life. What a lot of heartbreak. Please pray for the homeless people in our community and for the Poverty Concern teams that serve them.
